Young-At-Heart is our monthly program for seniors, featuring a covered-dish lunch and guest speakers presenting a variety of interesting topics.

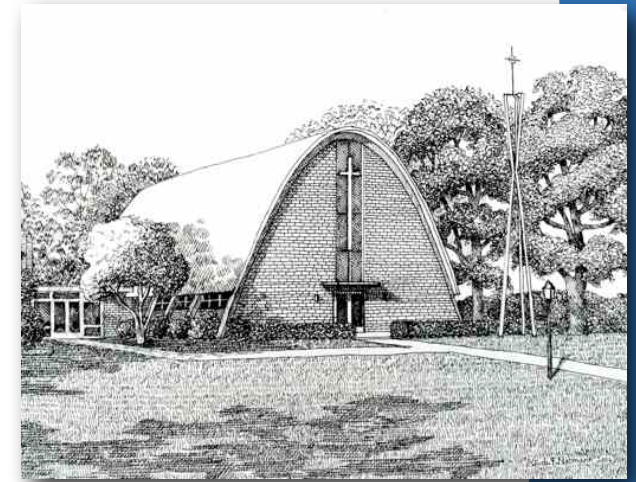
Kirk Night, held on the first Sunday evening of each month, is a time for children and adults of all ages to gather for food and fellowship.

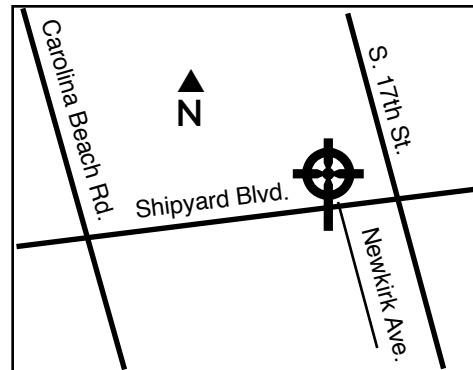
